e. Approve or Deny: Street Lights to be Added Nineteen (19) to Highway 99, Paying \$60,806.00 for Infrastructure Costs and Approximately \$114 a Month for Lighting.

This is the option the council chose which is to pay in full in advance rather than a monthly fee, specifically so the only bill the city will have after paying for infrastructure will be the electricity for the lights. MTE was able to save the city \$20,000 by cutting labor cost on the installation. This is for 19 lights along the SR99 with location dictated by TDOT.
